



STUDENT SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION

Middle School Camp (6th - 8th) | July 6 – 11 | High School Camp (9th - 12th) | July 20 – 25

Note: Students entering 9th grade may choose whether they'd like to attend Middle School or High School Camp. 12th grade students graduating this summer may still attend High School Camp.

CAMP COST:

\$450 p.p. | \$75 deposit due **3/30/25** | Remaining balance due **6/29/25**

To help with the cost, Epic Life Church is providing a **Summer Camp Scholarship Summit** where students can earn up to \$200 off their camp registration fee making camp only **\$250**.

SUMMER CAMP SCHOLARSHIP SUMMIT:

Epic Life Church is providing the opportunity for students to earn up to \$200 off their camp registration fee by completing the following 3 summits. All summits must be completed prior to attending camp, in their entirety, to earn the full scholarship. Partial scholarships may be awarded based on levels of participation.

SUMMIT #1: STUDENT GROUP ATTENDANCE

(Sundays: March 9th – June 22nd)

Earn **\$70** towards camp by attending 14 Sundays of Student Group between 3/9 – 6/22.

- 5th graders must attend 14 Sundays in the Elementary Class during the same time span.
- Students in a blended family, please talk with Sandy for adjusted requirements.

SUMMIT #2: SUNDAY SERVING

(Sundays: March 9th – June 22nd)

Earn **\$80** towards camp by serving 8 times on an Epic Sunday Serving Team. Must be completed by 6/22. Serving teams Include: Greeting, Refreshments, Band (9th grade & up), Tech Team and Kids)

SUMMIT #3: TRANSITIONAL YOUTH POP CAN DRIVE

(March 9th – May 25th | www.transitionalyouth.org)

Earn \$50 towards camp by participating in the Transitional Youth Pop Can Drive by collecting 500 pop cans/bottles by 5/25.

- Students will take ownership in their community and support their peers by collecting 500 can/bottles and dropping them off at Epic Life Church. All proceeds received through the drive will go directly to Transitional Youth who works to bring hope and healthy transformation to at-risk youth in our area.
- **Instructions:**
 1. Place name & number of cans on each bag submitted.
 2. Turn cans/bottles into a student leader at Epic Life Church.
 3. Each student participating will be issued a tally sheet to keep track of how many cans/bottles they have submitted.
 4. Cans/bottles do not have to be submitted at one time but may be dropped off anytime between 3/9 – 5/25.
- Resource ideas for collecting cans/bottles: family, friends, neighbors, co-works, etc.

TOTAL: \$200 in camp scholarships if all summits are completed in their entirety.
